What Does NeoSkin Rejuvenation Feel Like?

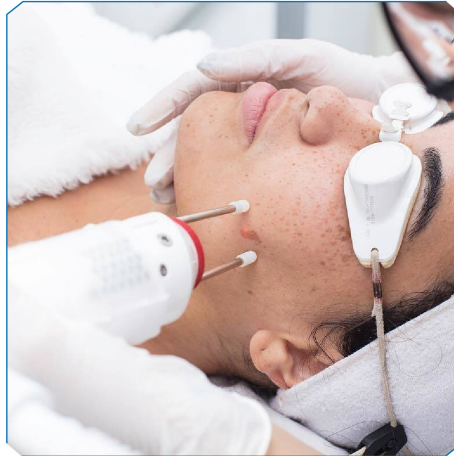

How Does NeoSkin Work?

- 1 The entire area (most commonly the face, neck, or chest) will be treated with laser light to globally stimulate collagen, which helps to minimize the appearance of fine lines, wrinkles, lax skin, and pores and improve overall tone & texture.
- 2 Individual concerns such as pigmented spots, PIH, acne spider veins or broken blood vessels will then be addressed with a more focused treatment. The laser energy will be applied directly to these concerns, which will disappear over time.
